The Government of Tamil Nadu has decided to issue No Objection Certificate to "Shri Barani Homoeopathy Medical College", Emapalli Village, Pilikkalmedu, Kokkarayanpettai (P.O), Thiruchengode, Namakkal District for starting of New Homoeopathy Medical College in admission capacity of 100 (Hundred) students to Bachelor of Homoeopathy Medicine and Surgery course.

They have also submitted the undertaking letter regarding the approval for building will be obtained from the DTCP office before starting the Course.

It is certified that :

- (a) the applicant owns and manages a 25 bedded hospital, which was established from 01.03.2018.
- (b) it is desirable to establish an Homoeopathy College for Bachelor of Homoeopathy Medicine and Surgery course in the public interest.

and

(c) establishment of Bachelor of Homoeopathy Medicine and Surgery course at Shri Barani Homoeopathy Medical College", Emapalli Village, Pilikkalmedu, Kokkarayanpettai (P.O), Thiruchengode, Namakkal by the Shri Barani Educational Foundation is feasible.

It is also certified that adequate clinical materials as per norms of the Central Council for Homoeopathy (CCH) is available with the proposed Medical College. It is further certified that in case, the applicant fails to create infrastructure for the course as per Central Council for Homoeopathy (CCH) norms and fresh admission are stopped by the Central Government, the State Government shall take over the responsibility of the students already admitted in the college with the permission of the Central Government.
